## ORDER

## HERNDON, Chief Judge:

This matter comes before the Court on Movant's motions to withdraw as counsel of record for plaintiffs in the above captioned actions. The law firm of Schlichter Bogard & Denton, LLP through Kristine K. Kraft, moves for leave to withdraw as counsel of record for plaintiffs Samantha Stovall, Kasey Smith, Jordan Barker, and S.B., a Minor, by and through her Next Friend Sharon Billings. Movant reports that plaintiffs Plaintiff Fact Sheet are significantly overdue. According to movant, counsel has expended significant efforts in communicating with plaintiffs about the need to complete the Plaintiff Fact Sheet and has made numerous attempts to contact plaintiffs to no avail.

Upon consideration of the motions, the Court finds that movant has complied with the requirements of Local Rule 83.1(g) and **ORDERS** as follows:

The motion to withdraw as counsel is **GRANTED**.<sup>4</sup>

**Further**, the Court directs Movant to serve a copy of this order of withdrawal within 7 days upon all counsel of record and upon unrepresented parties as required by Local Rule 83.1.
