## ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW AS COUNSEL OF RECORD

- 3. The Plaintiff must enter his or her appearance *pro se* in writing or file a written substitution of counsel withing forty-five (45) days of entry of this Order; and
- 4. If the Plaintiff fails to appear *pro se* or with new counsel within forty-five (45) days of entry of this Order, the Court may dismiss

Plaintiff's claims without prejudice on its own motion or upon motion by the Defendants.
