By Interim Reports Nos. 6 through 6J, Lead Class Counsel submitted for approval fee recommendations for a total of 1,717 Category I opt-in claims filed by PSC and non-PSC attorneys.

By Pretrial Order No. 33(A), the Court established a deadline of December 1, 2001 for submitting Claim Forms to Request Fees and Costs.


Class Counsel received 15 additional Category I claims before the December 1, 2001 deadline. Two other attorney claimants requested approval to file claims after the December 1, 2001 deadline, and written explanations were provided. In cooperation with Defense Counsel, Class Counsel now submit this Interim Report 6K concerning all 17 additional non-Steering Committee Category I claims which were filed by 9 attorneys, accepting all those claims as appropriate to recommend for payment.

Attached as Exhibit A to this motion is a proposed distribution schedule listing the proposed fees for the 17 claims included in this submission. A detailed

list of these claims, which includes the names of the injured persons, has been filed under seal. We respectfully submit this payment schedule for the Court's consideration.


