By Interim Reports Nos. 7 through 7P, Lead Class Counsel submitted 1,070 PSC and non-PSC Category II opt-in fee claims for approval. Fees for those claims were approved by Settlement Implementation Orders Nos. 7 through 7P.

By Pretrial Order No. 33(A), the Court established a deadline of December 1, 2001 for filing Claim Forms to Request Fees and Costs.

Since Settlement Implementation Orders Nos. 7 through 7P were entered, and before the December 1, 2001 deadline, Class Counsel have received additional Category II claims. In addition, the Court granted approval for an additional claim to be filed beyond the December 1, 2001 deadline. In cooperation with Defense Counsel, Class Counsel now submit this Interim Report 7Q concerning 12 additional non-Steering Committee Category II claims filed by 7 non-PSC attorneys.

Attached as Exhibit A to this motion is a proposed fee distribution schedule listing the proposed fee awards for each of the claims included in this submission.

A detailed list of these claims, which includes the name of the injured person, has been filed under seal.
