ORDER RE MATTERS CONSIDERED
AT APRIL 7, 2004 HEARING

The following orders are necessitated by the pending motions and issues raised at the hearing held on April 7, 2004.

I. FACT SHEET

Pending is the parties' Joint Motion to Approve Fact Sheet. The Joint Motion is GRANTED. Consistent with the Cost Order Re: Production of Core Documents by Defendant Wyeth, dated April 7, 2004, Wyeth will pay \$0.07 per page for electronic copies, \$0.09 per page for black and white copies, \$1.00-\$2.50 per page for color copies, and \$10.00 per videotape for copies of those documents requested from plaintiffs after inspection. Plaintiffs whose cases have been transferred to this proceeding already will complete the Fact Sheet within 60 days. Plaintiffs whose cases are transferred after the date of this Order will complete the Fact Sheet within 90 days after the Conditional Transfer Order becomes final.

II. IDENTIFICATION OF SALES REPRESENTATIVES


Pending is Plaintiffs' Motion to Abate the Statute of Limitations for Personal Injury Cases and/or Other Alternatives. Plaintiffs will submit no later than April 14, 2004, additional briefing and legal authority on a state-by-state basis regarding (i) the effect of naming "John Doe" defendants and (ii) the proposition that the Court has authority to "abate" the statute of

limitations. Wyeth may respond no later than April 21, 2004. Wyeth will also advise the Court and plaintiffs' Lead Counsel no later than April 14, 2004, of how many days it will take for Wyeth to provide the information described in its response to Request No. 1 of Defendants' Response to Plaintiffs' First Request for Production, Part One, once it receives from Lead Counsel a list of plaintiffs' prescribing physicians.

III. DEFENDANTS' STEERING COMMITTEE

Wyeth will submit the names of nominees to the proposed Defendants' Steering Committee, accompanied by their curriculum vitae, by April 14, 2004.
