SUGGESTION OF REMAND

JESSE M. FURMAN, United States District Judge:

After advising the Court that Plaintiff in the above-captioned member case had reached a settlement with New GM, the parties requested that the case be transferred to the transferor court for a hearing to confirm Plaintiff’s ability and capacity to knowingly settle her claims and execute the settlement. (*See* 14-CV-5331, Docket Nos. 203, 204).

Both parties having agreed that a limited remand is appropriate (*see* 14-MD-2543, Docket No. 2911), and in light of the case-specific findings needed to effectuate the settlement, the Court formally suggests that the Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation (“JPML”) remand *Irvin v. General Motors LLC* (14-CV-5331 (S.D.N.Y); 14-CV-0090 (E.D. Mo.)) to the transferor court for the limited purpose of allowing the transferor court to conduct a competency hearing in connection with Plaintiff’s acceptance of a proposed settlement. *See* Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litig. R. 10.1, 10.3.

The Clerk of Court is directed to send a copy of this Order to the JPML and to terminate 14-CV-5331, Docket No. 203.
