**LEAD AND LIAISON COUNSEL'S REPLY IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR
FINAL DISTRIBUTION FROM COMMON BENEFIT FUND**

Ford's Response to Lead and Liaison Counsel's Motion for Final Distribution from Common Benefit Fund (Dkt. 647) made it appear that there is a dispute between Plaintiffs' Lead and Liaison Counsel ("Plaintiffs' Counsel") and Ford. There is no dispute.

While Plaintiffs' Counsel believe they are entitled to \$117,380.60, they recognize that the fund only contains \$47,959.60. Accordingly, Plaintiffs' Counsel concluded their motion with a request for only the amount available in the Fund, divided as per their agreement, and submitted a proposed Order reflecting same. Ford's response "respectfully requests that the Court's order approve a distribution of only the amount in the Fund and that the order close the Fund after this final distribution has been made." Plaintiffs' Counsel agree.
