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STIPULATED ORDER REGARDING MDL-1718 DOCUMENT DEPOSITORY

In its Suggestion of Remand and Final MDL Pretrial Order for Remanded Cases (the “Remand Order”) entered on April 5, 2012, this Court ordered Defendant Ford Motor Company (“Defendant” or “Ford”) to maintain the MDL-1718 Document Depository until such time as the last of all transferred cases is resolved:

Pursuant to the Court’s Case Management Order, dated June 15, 2006 [D.E. 18], Defendant was ordered to establish and maintain a document depository. Defendant is to maintain the document depository until the last transferred case in this MDL proceeding is resolved. Access to the document depository will be permitted only for litigation of the transferred cases.

Remand Order, § C.3, at p. 4 (Dkt. 618) (brackets in original).

During the course of these MDL-1718 proceedings, numerous cases that were transferred into MDL-1718 have been remanded to their transferor courts. Of those remanded cases, only 19 remain pending in their transferor courts:


