
Dear Claims Administrator:

Enclosed please find additional documentation supplementing the application in the above-referenced matter, specifically with respect to attorney fee benefits. As noted in the original application, Ms. McNeill was represented by counsel prior to February 2, 2002. Unfortunately, when I submitted the application, I did not have a copy of the fee agreement that Ms. McNeill had with her prior attorney who handled her case beginning January 17, 2001.
