

Dear Andrew:

My client will accept your offer to replace the engines and chassis in units 5, 10, 14, 62 and 69. Ford acknowledges that my client will not waive its rights to the other fifteen (15) units that are still at issue in this lawsuit. As we have provided in terms of a bid sheet, Ford would owe my client \$245,000. This is \$49,000 per unit to replace these engines, chassis and remount charges. In addition, we have a 40% contingency agreement with our client. In order to fully reimburse my client the \$245,000, we would need a total of \$410,000 or \$165,000 in fees in order to deduct our 40% attorneys fees and leave our client with the \$245,000. I am putting a signature block on the bottom of this letter for you to sign so that not only the issues of these five (5) units are resolved but the attorneys fees regarding them are as well. Please sign the bottom that the payment by Ford of \$410,000 will resolve units 5, 10, 14, 62 and 69.
