ORDER

The Common Benefit Fee Committee’s (“CBFC”) Unanimous Motion for Third Distribution of Common Benefit Funds (Doc. No. 3311) is GRANTED as set forth below.

The creation of the CBFC, the funding and disbursements made from the MDL 1507 Fee and Cost Trust Account (“Common Benefit Fund”), and the creation of a “Holdback Fund” were discussed in the August 1, 2014 Order.¹ The CBFC has requested a third disbursement from the Common Benefit Fund based on the percentage allocation to firms performing common benefit work that was the basis of the August 1, 2014 Order.² No firm has objected to its or any other firm’s percentage based on the final allocation approved by the Court.

The CBFC also requested reimbursement of certain approved expenses for which two law firms, Provost Umphrey and The Calwell Practice were not previously reimbursed. The amounts below for these two firms include that reimbursement. The CBFC asked that \$50,000.00 remain in the Common Benefit Fund to pay for costs associated with management of the fund and any recent fees or expenses incurred but not yet tallied or evaluated.
