(Court convened)

THE COURT: Sorry we're late, folks. We're calling to order the YAZ and Yasmin MDL 2100 status conference.

The first matter on the agenda is the update on the gallbladder resolution program. Mr. Burg and Mr. Stoffelmayr are present at the podium to address these issues. Who wants to --

MR. BURG: Your Honor, Michael Burg. Thank you, Your Honor.

As you know, there was a presentation that was done earlier as to how we're coming with the lien resolution.

One of the problems that we're facing deals with the states not responding to the requests, and I understand that the Court is going to discuss that and potentially do what it can do to see if we can get the states to respond so we can hopefully get those settlement amounts to our clients.

THE COURT: I guess we got about 35 states that are not responding at this point so we need to do something to try to get them to respond.

MR. BURG: That's correct, Your Honor.

THE COURT: Okay. Anything Mr. Stoffelmayr, anything else on that?

MR. STOFFELMAYR: No. All I'd add for the record is, this morning we submitted the third of what I guess will be eight or nine lists of plaintiffs whose cases have been

resolved as a part of the gallbladder resolution program that's under CMO 64.

THE COURT: Okay, great. Next one is generic fact discovery, Bayer cases.

MR. BURG: Your Honor, I understand there was a deposition taken either yesterday or today. We're moving forward with that. I think both parties are moving forward cooperatively in that manner and we're proceeding accordingly.

MR. STOFFELMAYR: Nothing to add, Your Honor.

THE COURT: All right. And so we have CMO 65 that the Court has issued, which gives direction to the party with respect to designating certain cases, and parties have now complied with that, and I've asked the parties to submit plaintiff fact sheets to assist the Court in further designating cases, so if there's -- if the PSC contacts individual lawyers about assisting in being able to forward those to the Court, I appreciate everybody's cooperation on that.

Mr. Burg, is there anything you want to address with respect to this issue?

MR. BURG: No, Your Honor.

We are going to proceed pursuant to the Court's order, and we've talked to defense counsel about making sure that the plaintiff fact sheets are delivered to Your Honor

so you'll be able to make your selections. 1 THE COURT: Mr. Stoffelmayr? 2 3 MR. STOFFELMAYR: Nothing to add, Your Honor. THE COURT: All right. PFO case selection on that 4 is consistent with the other part of that. That's agenda 5 6 item four. Do you have anything else to add on that? 7 MR. BURG: Nothing, Your Honor. 8 MR. STOFFELMAYR: No, Your Honor. 9 THE COURT: And VTE settlements, I also issued an 10 order relative to that, and on the settlements in general but VTE in particular, and expect both sides to work 11 12 together in good faith to continue to settle or at least negotiate in good faith on these issues. And I understand 13 14 the parties are meeting. It's -- negotiations are 15 continuing. 16 Anything you want to talk about that, Mr. Burg? 17 MR. BURG: Your Honor, no.
