IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:


Any party or claimant involved in a settlement under the terms of Pretrial Orders Nos. 53 and 25 who has had portions of a settlement amount deducted for deposit in the MDL 1431 Fee and Cost Account or who has been advised by Bayer that a negotiated settlement may be subject to the MDL holdback may challenge the holdback by submitting, no later than 15 days from the receipt of a written holdback notice from Bayer, an e-mail request to Special Master Roger Haydock (rhaydock@arb-forum.com), with copies to the PSC ( Ron Goldser: [rsg@zimmreed.com](mailto:rsg@zimmreed.com)) and Bayer (Leanne DeShong: [ldeshong@shb.com](mailto:ldeshong@shb.com)) and any other parties involved in the matter, explaining why the holdback, in whole or in part, is not appropriate. Within 15 days after receiving a copy of the request, the PSC and Bayer may submit a reply. Within 8 days after receipt of this reply, the moving party or claimant may submit a response. Within 15 days after the time permitted to submit a response, Special Master Haydock will issue a decision. This decision will not preclude any party or claimant from later submitting a request to
